KYOKUSHIN WORLD FEDERATION and Yin-Yang Club, on the occasion of its 50th Anniversary, presents the 2nd KWF World Cup, to be held at the Mendizorrotza Municipal Pavilion in the city of Vitoria-Gasteiz (Spain).



The event will take place from 4th to the 7th of June 2026, and all members of the Kyokushin World Federation, as well as the different organizations collaborating with KWF, are invited.

Vitoria-Gasteiz is the administrative capital of the Basque Country Autonomous Community, located in the north of Spain.

This city has been awarded as the European Green Capital 2012 and Global Green City 2019.



The city is located 80 km from the Guggenheim Museum in Bilbao and only 40 km from the Álava countryside, internationally known for its excellent wines.

Vitoria-Gasteiz is recognized for having one of the finest gastronomic traditions in Spain.

The organization will provide shuttle bus service from Bilbao Airport to the Official Hotel on Thursday, June 4, according to the arrival schedules of the different delegations. On Sunday, June 7, shuttle buses will depart from the Official Hotel to Bilbao Airport, scheduled 3 hours and 30 minutes prior to flight departures.

Round trip transportation from the Official Hotel to the Mendizorrotza Pavilion for Referees and Officials will also be provided.

In order to use this service, the Organization must receive complete and accurate information regarding flight arrival and departure schedules. It will be understood that those who do not provide correct and timely information will not be able to use this service.

**VISAS:**

Participants in the 2nd KWF World Cup who require a visa to travel to Spain must obtain it in their own country.

The Organization will not process visas; however, an invitation letter for the 2nd KWF World Cup will be provided.

GENERAL RULES

In order to ensure the proper conduct of the Championship, participation is restricted to highly qualified competitors, as this event is not suitable for beginners.

KWF reserves the right to modify categories if a minimum number of competitors is not reached.

All competitors must be correctly registered on the KUMITE TECHNOLOGY platform in the discipline, category, and weight in which they wish to participate. Any competitor who does not correctly comply with this requirement will not be allowed to participate in the Championship.

The Kyokushin World Federation, organizer of the 2nd KWF World Cup, will conduct the Championship in accordance with KWF rules in the disciplines of Kumite (Knock-Down) and Kata, in the Children, Youth, Junior, Senior, and Master categories.

The registration platform will be Kumite Technology, where the representative of each country must correctly register competitors, coaches, referees, and officials, in accordance with the Championship instructions regarding discipline, category, and weight.

The registration deadline is April 30, 2026.

COMPOSITION OF PARTICIPATING DELEGATIONS

Country Representative or Head of Delegation

Maximum of two coaches per six competitors

Minimum of one judge or referee per country

CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION

The weigh-in and registration for the Championship will take place on June 4, 2026, at the Official Hotel (Ciudad de Vitoria).

For the proper conduct of the registration process, all delegation members must be present together and at the same time.

SCHEDULE: 9:30 – 14:00 / 15:00 – 20:00

DOCUMENTATION TO BE PRESENTED AT REGISTRATION

- Parental or legal guardian authorization for participation (minors under 18 years of age only).
- Competitor liability waiver (participants over 18 years of age).
- Official identification document (National ID or Passport – original document required; photocopies or mobile phone images will not be accepted), for verification of nationality and age.
- KWF Passport or official document issued by the organization to which the competitor belongs.
- Document certifying payment of the Championship registration fee.
- Medical certificate for all competitors (including Kata competitors).
- Each competitor must hold and present personal insurance covering any accident during the competition.
- Each competitor must have and present their own protective equipment in accordance with KWF rules.

REFEREES AND JUDGES

The officiating team will perform its duties under the supervision of the Chief Judge, Shihan Antonio Piñero; the Secretary General, Shihan André Drewniak; and the Director of Refereeing, Shihan Fernando Pérez.

The Kumite Technology platform will conduct the draw on June 4, 2026, starting at 22:00.

Shihan Fernando Pérez will conduct the Refereeing Course on Thursday, June 4, at the Official Hotel (Ciudad de Vitoria), from 17:00 to 20:00.

Attendance is mandatory for all referees and judges who wish to officiate at the Championship. Official uniform must be worn.

The course is free of charge, except for those who wish to obtain the official KWF International Judge or International Referee certification.

International Judge: €75 (minimum requirement: 2º Dan and National Referee)

International Referee: €100 (minimum requirement: 3º Dan and International Judge)

OFFICIAL UNIFORM:

- Dark blue trousers.
- Short-sleeved blue shirt.
- White bow tie.
- Whistle.

COACH:

- Must be registered on the Kumite Technology platform.
- Maximum of one coach per three competitors.
- The coach must wear the official tracksuit of their country or team.
- Coaches who do not strictly comply with these requirements will not be allowed to accompany competitors onto the tatami.
