2nd Bulletin of the 2nd KWF World Cup

Rules and Guidelines for the Development of the Competition

For the proper execution and smooth running of the championship, it is essential to recognize that the support of referees, coaches, and members of the organization is fundamental. We must convey to all participants and spectators an image of seriousness and respect, with punctuality being the first principle to uphold.

Referees – Judges

THURSDAY 04/06/2026

9:30 Registration of competitors, referees, and coaches at the facilities of the official Hotel, **CIUDAD DE VITORIA**. Until 14:00.

15:00 Registration reopens for those who were unable to register in the morning. Until 20:00.

17:00 Refereeing course for all participants in the Championship. (Everyone must wear the official uniform.)

20:30 Meeting for **COACHES, REFEREES, and COUNTRY REPRESENTATIVES**.

22:00 Draw for competitor matchups in the different **KUMITE** categories and publication of the starting order for the **KATA** discipline in all categories.

All of the above under the supervision of Shihan: **ANTONIO PIÑERO**

Attendance at this course is mandatory in order to participate as a referee or judge in the 2nd KWF World Cup.

There will also be an International Judge Certification Course.

The fee for this course is €75, and participants must hold at least a 2nd Dan rank.

For the International Referee Course, the fee is €100. Participants must hold at least a 3rd Dan rank and be a certified national referee in their country.

All judges and referees must be registered on the Kumite Technology platform in order to be properly attended to by the organization (gifts, meals, etc.).

The course must be attended wearing the official uniform of each organization.

All referees and judges must arrive at the Mendizorroza Sports Hall one hour before the event in order to attend the meeting called by the Chief Referee Director, Shihan Fernando Pérez, where they will receive the necessary instructions for the proper functioning of the championship at each tatami area.

Coaches

The participation of coaches in the championship is essential to ensure the smooth running of the event. Coaches must maintain appropriate behavior and wear the required uniform (full tracksuit of their club or country). Those who do not comply with this requirement will not be allowed to sit beside their competitor. Items that distort the professional image of the coach will not be permitted, such as caps, shorts, swimwear, mobile phones, etc.

Coaches must behave respectfully toward referees and competitors, avoiding standing up from their chairs either to encourage competitors excessively or to protest in an inappropriate manner. Any action contrary to the championship regulations must be reported to the tatami chief or the referee director.

Coaches must ensure that their competitors are ready in the warm-up area with the appropriate protective equipment and remain attentive when called to participate.

When a competitor does not appear at the tatami, they will be called over the public-address system up to three times at one-minute intervals. After this period, the competitor will be declared the loser and will no longer have the opportunity to participate.

Competition brackets and pools will be available on the Kumite Technology website.

A weight tolerance of 500 grams will be allowed during weigh-in. Competitors who do not meet the weight requirement of their registered category will be disqualified and may not move to another category.

All competitors must provide their own protective equipment, which must comply with KWF regulations or equivalent standards and must be white in color.

All Kata and Kumite regulations, including weight divisions, age categories, ranks, and protective equipment requirements, can be found on the championship website and in Bulletin No. 1.

Only one coach per competitor will be allowed in the designated coaching area.

Participation Rules

All competitors must have paid their registration fee and present proof of payment during check-in to the KWF Treasurer, Mr. Tomás López, or make the payment during check-in.

If there is an insufficient number of competitors in any Kata or Kumite category, the organization reserves the right to:

- Modify the proposed categories
- Offer competitors the option to move to the next higher category
- Consider cancelling the category

Affected participants will be informed as soon as possible.

All underage competitors must submit the parental authorization form attached to this documentation, signed by their legal guardian (Appendix to Bulletin No. 1).

Competitors must have sports insurance covering participation in the championship and present proof of coverage during check-in.

Due to the difficulties involved in completing the medical examination form, a medical certificate confirming fitness to participate in sports activities may also be submitted (Appendix to Bulletin No. 1).

The championship organization reserves the right to refuse the participation of any club, country, or competitor who does not comply with the competition regulations and to disqualify any participant in cases of intentional falsification regarding age or weight.

Only individuals with official accreditation will be allowed access to the competition area. (Photos and videos may be taken from the spectator stands.)

Any modifications arising before the championship, such as changes in weight categories or schedules, will be communicated as soon as possible.

Kumite brackets and Kata performance orders will be prepared only with competitors who have completed the check-in process.

June 5th, 2026 — Morning Session (Approximately 09:00 to 13:00)

All participants (referees, officials, competitors, and coaches) must arrive at the Mendizorroza Sports Hall one hour before the start.

The competition will begin with all Kata categories, including finals.

It will continue with the Children, Youth, and Junior Kumite categories, excluding semifinals.

June 5th, 2026 — Afternoon Session (Approximately 15:00 to 19:00)

The session will begin with the semifinals of the Children, Youth, and Junior Kumite categories.

Afterwards, the youngest students of Club Yin Yang, under the direction of Shihan: Naroa Lezkano, will perform a Kyokushin Karate demonstration.

The event will continue with the finals for the Children, Youth, and Junior categories.

The day will conclude with the trophy ceremony for the Kata and Kumite events held during the session.

Tameshiwari demonstration led by Shihan LUIS M^a DORADO and Senpai ALBERTO CIMAVILLA.

Start of the KUMITE Finals: SUB-21, SENIOR, and MASTER categories.

Award ceremony and closing of the 2nd KYOKUSHIN WORLD FEDERATION WORLD CUP.
